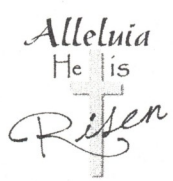

EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION:

Easter Sunday puts the crown on our Holy Week services and for us Catholics we now begin a period of time 50 days to be exact when we celebrate all that the Resurrection of the Lord means to us. Easter Sunday is the pattern and purpose of all other Sundays of the year and offers us a time to reflect on how the followers of Jesus came to receive and understand his resurrection from the dead and what that means for us as his disciples. "The Lord is truly risen, Alleluia" proclaims today's entrance hymn. All three readings speak to this foundational message of Easter Day. In the Acts of the Apostles, Peter witnesses the life, death and resurrection of Christ and draws out its significance for us. Everyone who believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins and everlasting life. The most important message of the resurrection is that it is the gift of freedom; freedom from a death that would mark the end; freedom from remorse, of cynicism, and of despair. Resurrection for believers is a gift to be free to make CHOICES: to pray, to love, to forgive, to hope and to rejoice. *This is the day the Lord has made. Let us rejoice and be glad!"*
